Nearly a decade of Tory and LibDem austerity has left neurodivergent people and our families struggling without services and without rights. **On 12 December, you have the chance to change that.**

Labour will:

- stop and reverse austerity cuts
- scrap and replace Universal Credit
- restore funding to our schools and Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) budgets
- save our National Health Service from cuts and privatisation
- make all prescriptions free
- incorporate the UN Convention into UK law, extending protection against disability discrimination

Our Autism and Neurodiversity Manifesto also pledges:

- workplace accessibility assessments
 - state provision of assessment of dyslexia, dyspraxia and other neurodivergent conditions in adults
 - accessible, local, early care and support services instead of distant, long-stay Assessment and Treatment Units (ATUs)
 - neurodivergence to be a protected characteristic under the Equality Act with the same legal protections as disability
 - regulation of treatments aimed at autistic and other neurodivergent people
 - neurodiversity to be included in core training for education workers
